
- Coffee and tea at break time



HISTORICAL BACKGROUND

CLC was inspired by the experience of Pentecost (Acts 2:1-13); the profound and enriching missionary experience of many of its missionaries around the world; and coupled with the great desire to contribute to the ever-growing challenges of qualitative teaching and learning of foreign languages in Kenya and Africa as a whole. Thus, the Institute of the Consolata Missionaries began to nurse the idea of constructing and establishing a language centre, dedicated to Our Lady Consolata.

The principal objective of setting up the language centre was to facilitate language learning and cultural immersion for missionaries and other people coming to Kenya and going to foreign lands for diverse purposes to work, study, leisure etc.; regardless of their religious, cultural ideological or political affiliations. After years of deliberation and hard work, the construction of the centre kicked off in 2008 and upon completion of the physical structures, the **CONSOLATA LANGUAGE CENTRE - CLC** opened its doors to the first group on the 14th of January 2010.
